“ELSECAR WWI POPPY TRAIL”

Tragically, Elsecar lost 72 lads/men in World War 1 (32 of whom are listed on the memorial tablet in Holy Trinity Church Elsecar). Members of Holy Trinity Church; poppy volunteers; "Great Place Wentworth and Elsecar" and the Heritage Centre have come together to create a commemorative poppy trail. The trail covers 16 streets.

A poppy and a memory card for each soldier will be displayed on lampposts close to where the men lived prior to leaving for the First World War. The poppies will start to appear in the week commencing Monday 15th October and will remain in place until the 5th December, the date when the last soldier from Elsecar passed away.

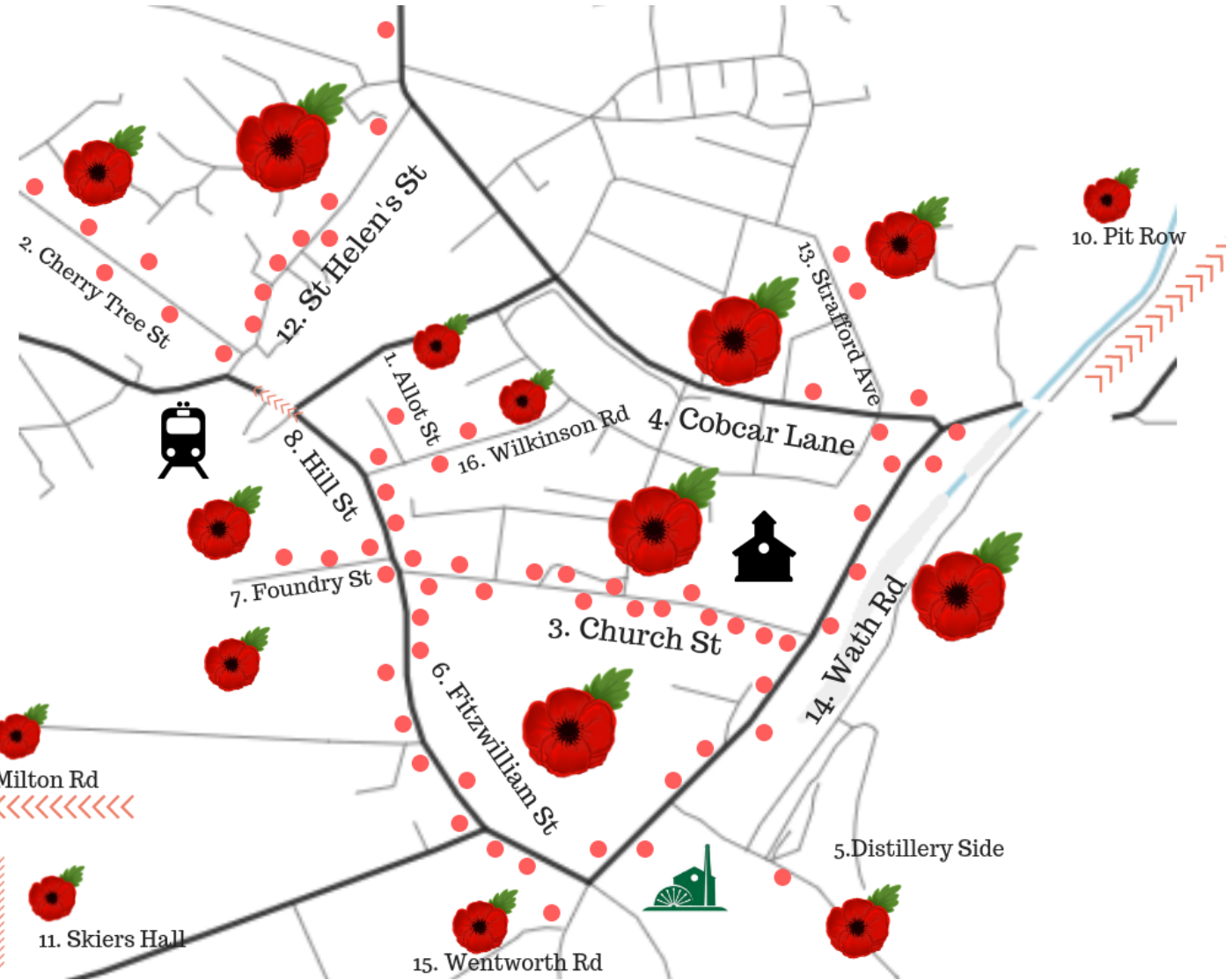
